Large tents, awnings, gazebos and extra vehicles may be treated as an extra pitch during peak times.

Please note that there is a minimum booking period of 3 nights for Bank Holiday weekends and 2 nights for weekends in July and August.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Folly Farm is a quiet, family owned campsite with 2 small fields for tent use only and a walled area for caravans. During quiet periods it is possible for tents to be included with caravans but during our busy periods this is not always possible. Due to planning restrictions caravans are never allowed on the tent fields.

Folly Farm has basic facilities and tends to be enjoyed by those who want a simple campsite. We encourage individuals, couples, quiet groups and families to stay. We do not have a shop or playground however there is space to play ball and for children to explore. There is a pub within short walking distance across the fields and more further a field for those who like a longer walk or short drive. All the amenities of Bourton-on-the Water are 2.5 miles from the site.

The site has no external lighting which makes it an attractive place to stay for those who enjoy stargazing or simply like to sleep in total darkness. However it is imperative that all campers remember to bring a working torch and use it after dark. There are many potential trip hazards if you do not use a torch.

We do not allow open fires for safety reasons and to protect the grass. We welcome BBQ's but insist that all disposable BBQ's are raised to prevent the ground becoming scorched and that you bring some means of lifting the BBQ's with you.

We have a weekly skip collection for rubbish and a series of recycling bins. We ask all our visitors to help keep the costs of the site down and help protect the environment by making sure all rubbish is disposed of appropriately. Please do not leave unwanted equipment behind as this will have a knock on effect on our prices.

We have a basic toilet, wash and shower block which is maintained by the campsite manager. Please inform him immediately of any blockages or cleaning issues. We are not on mains drainage so it is very important that the bins provided are used and nothing other than toilet paper is flushed and that fat or foodstuffs are not put in the drains.

Folly Farm is in "an area of outstanding natural beauty". We are obliged to maintain all the dry stone walls. These walls have been looked after for hundreds of years. Please ensure that children are prevented from climbing on the walls and that under no circumstances are any stones removed.

Folly Farm is situated above the village of Cold Aston and within the parish of Notgrove. We have two public footpaths that run through the site. We hope that our visitors will enjoy the footpaths whilst also respecting the privacy of the neighboring properties through which they run. There are miles of wonderful walks to be enjoyed in the area and lots of villages and (hilly) lanes to be discovered by walkers and cyclists or for the less energetic by car.
